BACKGROUND

Two Leo representatives serve on the Management Group. Each serves a term of two years appointed on an annual basis in rotation.

The role is to provide a youth perspective to the deliberations on the management group.

Although drawn from the Leo program, the successful representatives are expected to contribute across the range of matters considered by the management group.

The primary role is to read the Business Paper attend the management meeting and contribute to discussion. Management meetings are held in Sydney over a weekend in March/April, July/August and December each year.

Travel costs, accommodation and meals are covered by Lions Australia.

Applicants should have a reasonable expectation that they can attend the six Management meetings during their term.

ABOUT THE MANAGEMENT GROUP

The management group is comprised of the Council Chairperson, Executive Officer, Legal Officer, National Treasurer, and National Coordinators for Membership, Leadership, Youth and Community Projects and Marketing.

It meets three times a year to review the Council Business paper prior to its distribution and discuss other matters of relevance to the Lions in Australia and Papua New Guinea.

The Council is made up of 19 District Governors and is responsible for the governance of Lions Clubs within Australia and Papua New Guinea.


