Australian Lions Foundation ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting of the ALF will be held at the Multiple District Convention in Tamworth on **Friday afternoon at 4.00pm immediately following normal Convention business**. At this meeting delegates will be asked to approve a change for the Foundations operations with the presentation of a motion to approve an amended Deed under which the Foundation must abide.

Notice is given that the following Notice of Motion will be tabled for the consideration of members at the

Annual General Meeting of the Foundation to be held at the MD 201 Convention Tamworth commencing on or about 4.00pm o'clock on Friday 2nd May 2014:

"That this General Meeting consents to the following amendments to the Deed of Trust dated the 13th September, 1983 establishing the Australian Lions Foundation –

(i) An amendment confirming that the Funds of the Trust are held exclusively for the relief of persons in necessitous circumstances within Australia

(ii) An amendment confirming the obligation of the Trustees to act in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997 in order to maintain the endorsement of the Fund as a Deductible Gift Recipient.

and directs the Trustees by Deed of Amendment to amend the Deed of Trust accordingly."

Note: The adoption of the proposed Notice of Motion is required in consequence of changed legislation and in order to ensure that the Foundation retains its deductible gift recipient status. A copy of the proposed Deed of Amendment may be sighted at the Annual General Meeting upon request.

ALF donates \$50,000 to Drought Relief

The Foundation has recently donated \$50,000 to support those impacted throughout Queensland by the drought.
