**Past International Director Eric Carter**

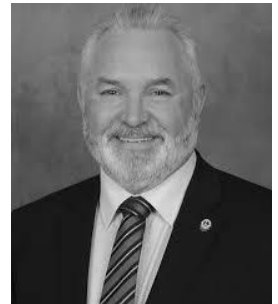
Lion Eric, a Lion for 28 years has held many positions within the association and continues to serve the association in many areas, especially within the area of Service.
