3. The Committee will set its own agenda – a true, grass-roots member committee. It has a mandate to seek out communities that need new Lions Clubs – a mandate from our Convention.

This can include:

- New specialty clubs
- Clubs to replace retiring clubs
- Clubs in new communities
- Club Branches
