



Lions Clubs International Flag Ceremony Recognition

Association Flags:

There are a standard set of flags used to recognize the association and its involvement.

- Lions Clubs International Flag
- United States of America (Recognition of where Lions was founded and our HQ)
- Flag of the President of the Association (Currently United States of America)
- United Nations Flag (Recognition of our involvement in its establishment and committee representation).

Local Flag Recognition (Australia)

At the local level, the member countries of the Constitution are acknowledged:

- Indonesia
- New Zealand (representing NZ and Islands of the South Pacific)
- New Caledonia
- Papua New Guinea.

If you have an International Lions Guest it is customary for their Flag to be recognized or if there are any specific guests attending or speaking that you feel their Country's flag should be recognized.

From a local perspective there are what we present...

- Leo Flag
- Indigenous Aboriginal Flag
- Australian Flag

The suggested order follows the Association Flags, CA flags, Guest Flags and then local flags.

1	Unites State of America
2	Lions Clubs International Flag
3	Flag of the country of the President
4	United Nations Flag
5	CA Flags (no particular order)
6	International Guests Flag (if applicable)
7	Local: Leo
8	Local: Aboriginal
9	Local: State (if applicable)
10	Local: Australia

The Australian Flag is always the last Flag and recognized with the National Anthem on its presentation.
